Healthcare Foundation Board Welcomes New Trustees

Sarasota Memorial Healthcare Foundation, Inc. is pleased to announce that **Philip A. Delaney, Jr., Ronald G. Gelbman** and **Margaret Wise** joined the board of trustees on October 1, 2008.

Philip A. Delaney, Jr., is president and chief executive officer of Northern Trust in Sarasota and Manatee Counties, a position he assumed in 1999. He joined Northern Trust in Chicago more than 30 years ago. Mr. Delaney previously served on the board of Sarasota Memorial Healthcare Foundation, Inc. from 2000 to 2007, serving as board chair in fiscal year 2005/2006.

Ronald G. Gelbman retired from Johnson & Johnson in April 2000, after serving as Worldwide Chairman of the Health Systems and Diagnostics Group. He was also a member of the executive committee of Johnson & Johnson. Mr. Gelbman began his career with Johnson & Johnson in 1972, serving various senior level positions throughout the company. Currently Mr. Gelbman serves as lead director of Haemonetics Corporation's board, and is a board member of Clockwork Home Services.

Margaret Wise, an entrepreneur, owned and operated several businesses in Jackson, Miss. before moving to Houston, Tex. Since moving to Sarasota in 1989, Mrs. Wise has devoted her time to a number of not-for-profit organizations. Appointed by former Governor Jeb Bush, she is currently serving her second four-year term on the Florida Arts Council. In 2002, she co-founded Designing Women Boutique, a charitable organization that supports arts and human services. Mrs. Wise previously served on the Healthcare Foundation's board from 2001 to 2007.
